Disclaimer : Please regard that I make conversions from the originally used and chosen materials with help of original brand thread cards + full skeins of variegated threads - but following my own taste of color and the feeling of what will go with that particular design rather than using so-called "official" conversion charts. Please regard that the piece is designed for the use of the "original" materials (variegated silks etc) and the effect and overall look can be quite different if you use other materials.

I do not endorse any of the nowadays offered "conversion packs" by some thread manufacturers as they rarely are made by comparison to the original materials I chose and which I have on my desk here "in person".
Nor do I support ANY other "comparable" threads which are dyed following my choice of materials + then offered in forums etc. as conversion for a particular Chatelaine design !

If you wish to use different materials feel free to do so, but please follow your own feelings, eyes and taste of color rather than buying "bulk" conversions !! I am not responsible if you do not like the look of the conversion materials.

If you want the piece to look the same, use the same :)

Thread approximations regarding used amounts are made with a software and may vary depending of the personal stitching habits. They are an approximation only !
